DEAR FRIENDS,

More than a year before our first students began their studies at Chicago Jesuit Academy in June 2005, I met a gentleman named Matt Botica and shared the initial business plan for CJA with him. Matt embraced the idea of CJA, and he moved heaven and earth to make CJA a reality as our founding board chair. Matt patiently and wisely mentored me through the earliest years of CJA's existence, and I could write volumes about his goodness, toughness and humility.

We lost Matt in March after a long and courageous battle against cancer, but he lives on with us each day here at CJA. Matt knitted into the fabric of CJA that "good enough" is never good enough for our students and alumni. Instead, we strive to invite each young person we serve to develop the full measure of their gifts and use those gifts in the service of others – just as Matt did. Matt refused to accept the idea that our students should ever be asked to do without or make do. He fought hard to ensure that music lessons, medical care, three nutritious meals and reading interventionists were all just part of a normal day at CJA for **Marehana, Trey** (please see page 4) and all our students.

From the first days of CJA's existence, Matt saw in each of our students his own children. He delighted in their successes and lost sleep and shed tears when they struggled. The only child of two loving immigrants, Matt knew firsthand how a great education could transform a person's life. He loved spending time with our alumni and learning about all that they were doing in high school, college and at the start of their careers. He was so proud of **Brandon, Orlando, Marvin, DaMarcus, Marques, ShaMarrion** (please see page 6) and all our alumni

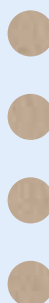
who work with our College & Career Persistence Team as they chart their unique paths to meaningful employment and strive to live their lives in the service of others.

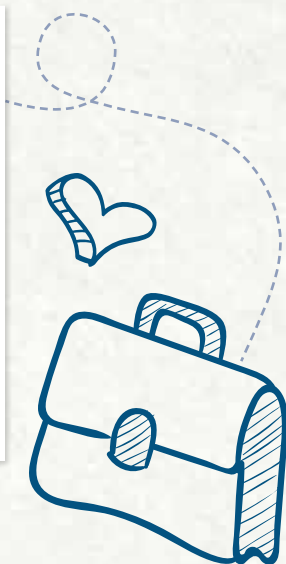
A day in the life of

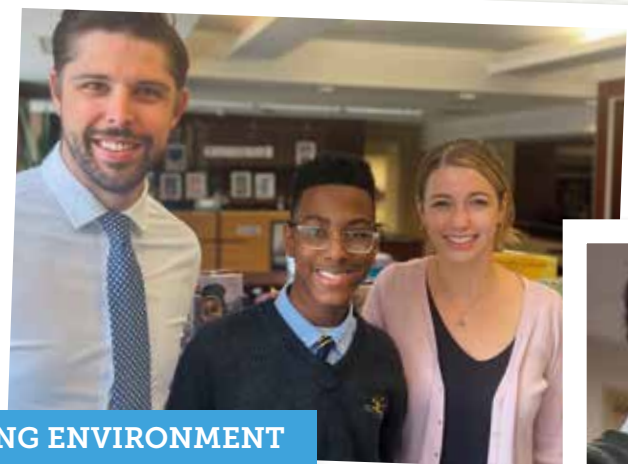
EXTENDED SCHOOL DAY WITH NUTRITIOUS MEALS

MAREHANA: I wake up at 6:00 a.m. My mom drives me and my brother to CJA so she doesn't have to drive to two different schools. Then I have breakfast. I feel happy and grateful I go to a school where they care for us.



MUSIC

TREY: I'm in Music Ensemble, and I love playing instruments. I play the piano, French horn and trumpet.



LOVING ENVIRONMENT

TREY: My advisors are Ms. Goldin and Mr. Schauer. I have grown fond of them. It makes me sad to leave CJA!

What has your journey been since CJA, and how was CJA involved?

Orlando: I live by the Grad-at-Grad values in my daily life. My time at CJA is a blueprint for my life. CJA pushes us to do what we want to. They don't force an agenda or judge. CJA is the friend that shows up, even when things are going bad. A different path was already in my mind, and I didn't know where to start. Where else to start but at CJA, the place that gives opportunities and opens doors?

Marques: CJA followed me through high school, college and after. CJA was constantly asking, "Do you need anything? There's this opportunity." CJA was always in my corner. I can't imagine my life without CJA.

Brandon: CJA taught me discipline and helped me become a greater person.

CJA helped me become the man I am today. I learned integrity and doing the right thing even when no one is looking.

CJA and Mr. Kemper always gave me the direction I needed. That was mind-blowing because this was coming from my grammar school! CJA goes straight to problem-solving. It keeps me determined, and it keeps me pushing.

Marques: CJA helped me when I was going down a path that wasn't right for me. I've always come out stronger. CJA has taught me a lot about getting knocked down but getting right back up again. CJA shows up in the way we need them to.

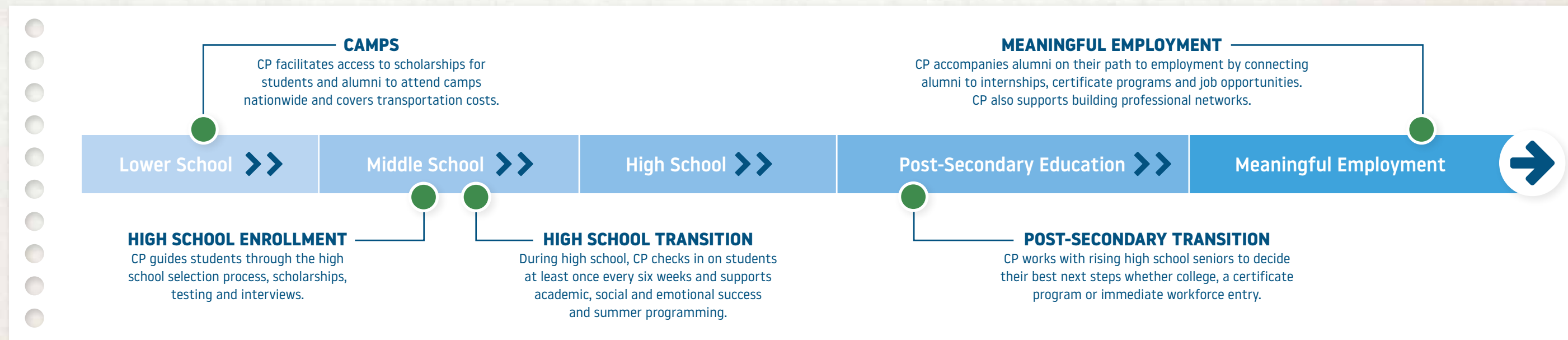
How have you made sacrifices to get to where you are?

Marvin: I have really ambitious goals. The sacrifices I make are for the greater good of what I want to do. In this world, you can't expect to receive something without giving first. I have to give everything I have if I want to be the best me and do what I want to do.

After I graduated from CJA, I saw the change within myself just from 5th grade to 8th grade. I knew this place deserved my time and commitment.

One of my goals is to be a benefactor here. That keeps me going and pushing to new heights. I want to give back to the place that invested in me first.

DaMarcus: If I hadn’t made the sacrifices I’ve made, I wouldn’t be where I am today. You have to give to get.

ShaMarrion: I make sacrifices because I don’t want my mom to have to worry. What I’m doing right now is so important that it could change my family’s life. At the end of the day, if it’s going to make my mom’s and my life better, it’s all worth it.

Who inspires you?

Orlando: My grandparents came to Chicago from Mississippi during the Great Migration. They were a hard-working class. They worked for everything they had. I have an obligation to be great to carry that on.

I have a little brother that’s watching. I know he watches everything I do, so I have to set an example.

DaMarcus: My mom inspired and supported me throughout my whole journey.

Marques: My dad. He’s gone through so many trials and tribulations.

He inspires me every single day, and I don’t tell him that enough. He makes me want to be better and persevere. I want to start a business together.

Brandon: My biggest inspiration is my grandma because she is 110% independent, but she also is so considerate of others.

Marvin: My mom. Whenever I felt discouraged, she would say, “Marvin, you could do anything you put your mind to. Just do it like the Nike sign.”

What has it been like working with your CP counselor?

Marvin: I can attest to getting help with even the smallest tasks: applying for FAFSA, financial aid and scholarships for high school. Mr. Kemper was there for me throughout that whole process through supportive words, sitting and helping me through the task or clarifying things. I wouldn’t have found the Ryan Scholarship at DePaul without the CP Team. To have an advocate in CP when I’m not sure of my next steps... that has been one of the biggest contributing factors to my growth. When I become a benefactor, I’m going to give to the CP Team.

ShaMarrion: I’m also a Ryan Scholar, and I have a full ride including room and board to DePaul! My CP Counselor encouraged me to apply. It’s wonderful – it’s an amazing experience. I’m also closer to my mom so she doesn’t have to worry.

DaMarcus: CJA has shown me a lot of support. If it weren’t for CJA, I wouldn’t have learned about the Wintrust internship during my junior year in college. Now, I’m at the Associate level at JP Morgan. The next level is Vice President, so I’m looking to climb the ranks and become VP of my group.

Marques: I appreciate CJA because if I’m going through a tough time, (CP Counselor) Ms. Olander is there. It’s like God checking in. Ms. O shows up for me. When I got my first apartment, Ms. O helped me get furniture through a partnership CJA has, and when I moved in, she was there all day

making sure everything fit and helping me decorate. This was on the weekend!

Orlando: CJA is always calling with love. With (CP Counselor) Ms. Breckenridge, there’s no pressure. It’s all love, and through her love, you hear your own voice telling you what you need to change.

Brandon: I’m 24, and I’m still talking to Mr. Kemper. That’s crazy. I’ve known him since I was 11! He has been an inspiration. I love hearing from him. He introduced me to (solar installation training program) 548, and that was life-changing. It’s the beginning of my career path, so that’s a big thing for me. Whenever I was lost, I knew Mr. Kemper could help. Now I have a job at a solar company, and I want to run the whole Chicagoland district. I will achieve that because I want what’s best for myself. I want to show CJA that they didn’t fail me, and I’ve grown up.

What’s the role of your CJA classmates and friends on your current path?

ShaMarrion: I room with three CJA alumni, including Marvin. When my other DePaul friends ask how long I’ve known them, I get to say almost 10 years! It’s comforting knowing the people I’m hanging out with now are people I’ve known for a very long time.

Marvin: We are all supportive brothers. That’s the best way to explain it. They’re a trusting, safe space in which I can confide. We uplift each other. I see values that CJA teaches, like seeking intellectual excellence and being

open to growth, within all of us. **Orlando:** They’ve been the inspiration. Seeing my classmates doing great makes me want to do great too.

Brandon: Everybody has their path. My classmates who took advantage of the opportunities CJA had to offer are successful, or we are on our way in part because of the opportunities CJA provides.

If you were talking to CJA’s 8th graders, what advice would you give them?

DaMarcus: Don’t be afraid to ask questions. Work hard and always stay connected with your CJA family. Challenge yourself. Always step outside your comfort zone because growth does not come from familiarity.

Marvin: Become comfortable with discomfort. Recognize when you’re not being open to growth and do it anyway because you’ll learn something from it or even excel at it.

ShaMarrion: Always stay connected because you get so many connections from CJA. The benefactors, the faculty, the alumni, they know people, and they will share opportunities you would not have known about.

Brandon: Use CJA as a support but come back when things are good, too. Try to stay as close as you can even after leaving.

Marques: Don’t forget about your CP Counselor. It’s easy to not answer the text or call, but I promise you, if you continue to reach out and make sure you are answering the calls, you will be great.

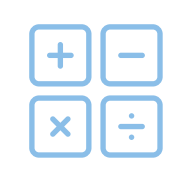


20 YEARS

OF THOUGHTFULLY GROWING AS A COMMUNITY

Chicago Jesuit Academy was founded in 2004, and in our first school year, we enrolled 19 pioneering young men. Since then, we have not stopped growing. We have always grounded ourselves in our Ignatian **Graduate-at-Graduation** values as we strive to be loving, open to growth, committed to doing justice and religious while seeking intellectual excellence. As we enter our 20th school year, we look forward to serving more than 310 CJA students, 290 alumni on active caseloads and 1,022 High School Bridge (HSB)

students. By the **2027-28** school year when we reach our full capacity, we will **serve 426 CJA students, 350+ alumni** on active caseloads and **2,000+ HSB students** across Chicago through our 19 partner elementary schools. We have grown intentionally while not sacrificing the depth and breadth of our relationships with our students and alumni. Each student and alumnus is known and loved. Our **nine hour school days, 11-month school years** and **co-teaching model** allow for

97% of our students completed the 2023-2024 school year testing above, on or within one grade of their age-appropriate grade level in Mathematics. Of these same students, 33% began the year two or more grade levels behind, 12% were three or more years behind.

personalized learning for each child. Our wraparound services include **four full-time social workers**, a full-time school **nurse** and a **team of learning interventionists**.

In addition to supporting our students as they enroll in their best-fit high schools, our **College & Career Persistence Team** accompanies our alumni through high school, college and on their unique journeys to meaningful employment. **We walk with our students from their enrollment at CJA in third grade through their 25th birthday as they grow to become men and women for others.**

In 2018, we created **High School Bridge (HSB)** because all students have the right to a well-resourced high school education, but choosing the right school is highly complicated without significant support. HSB works with students attending elementary schools in communities impacted by systemic disinvestment to navigate this complexity and to find and succeed in their best-fit high schools. Students enrolling in their best-fit high school are

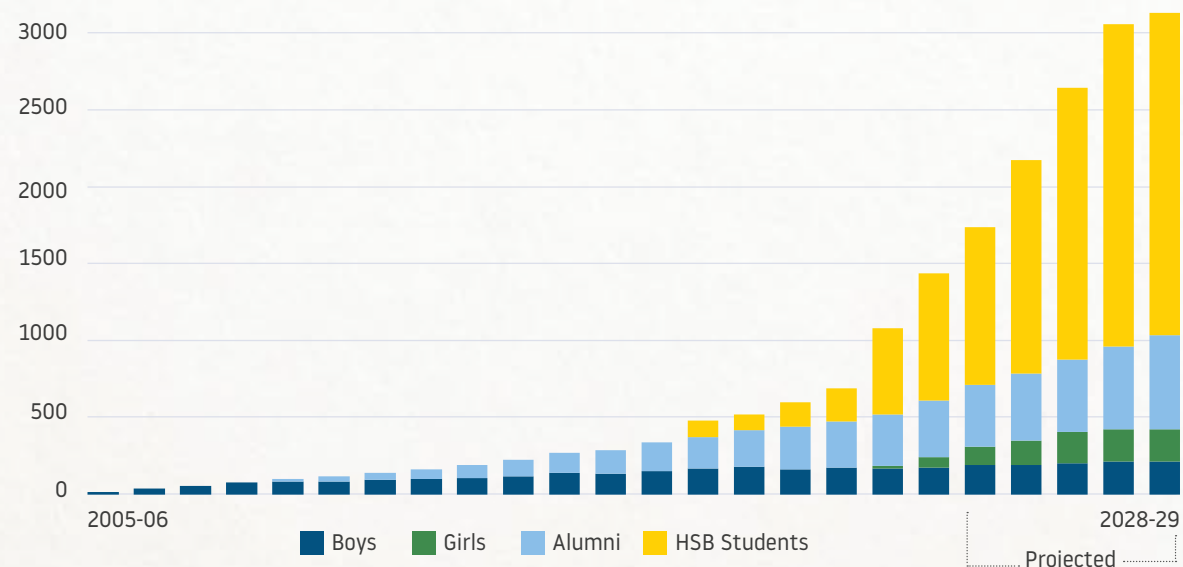


more likely to persist at that school, graduate on time and go on to earn a college degree. This program is provided at no cost to our partner schools.

Chicago Jesuit Academy is a loving and academically rigorous tuition-free Catholic elementary school for students and families from resilient communities impacted by historical disinvestment. We accompany our students and alumni from enrollment through the start of their careers as they develop their gifts and grow as men and women for others.

MEANS

Located in Austin on Chicago's West Side, CJA admits students to all grades in our lower and middle school without regard for their race, ethnicity or religion, and CJA enrolls 3rd-, 4th- and 5th-grade students without regard for their past levels of academic achievement.

We use small class sizes, extended school days and an 11-month school year to give personal care to our students and help them develop as whole persons.

We accompany our alumni on their unique paths to meaningful employment and support them throughout high school, their post-secondary education and the start of their careers, always welcoming them back as leaders at CJA and in the broader community.

CJA students, alumni, parents, faculty, staff, volunteers and benefactors listen to and learn from one another and make disciplined sacrifices to accomplish our shared mission.

We partner with other schools and the broader community to create access to better educational resources, confront systemic racism and remove obstacles to educational equity.

We call one another to find God in all things and be men and women for others who are open to growth, loving, religious, seeking intellectual excellence and committed to doing justice.

OUR FINANCIALS

Benefactors who choose to support CJA are investing in the long-term future of our students. That investment signals a belief in our students' promise – not only academically, but also as people who are committed to doing justice in the service of others.

SCHOLARSHIP LEVELS

Full Cost \$29,500/year

A Full-Cost Scholarship takes into account the approximate true cost per student per year at CJA. This cost is in line with the amount spent by many suburban public school districts whose average school day is three hours shorter and whose school year is two months shorter than CJA's.

Half Cost \$14,750/year

A Half-Cost Scholarship covers half of the cost of the extended school year, extended school day, full-time school nurse, social workers, reading and math interventionists and co-curricular programming which make a CJA education unique and exceptional.

Quarter Cost \$7,375/year

A Quarter-Cost Scholarship covers one quarter of the cost of a student's education throughout their time at Chicago Jesuit Academy.

Four-Year Sustainable Scholarship

More important than the amount of a scholarship commitment is the commitment to support a student throughout their fifth- through eighth-grade years at CJA. We invite our benefactor community to consider a four-year commitment of an amount that is the best fit for them.



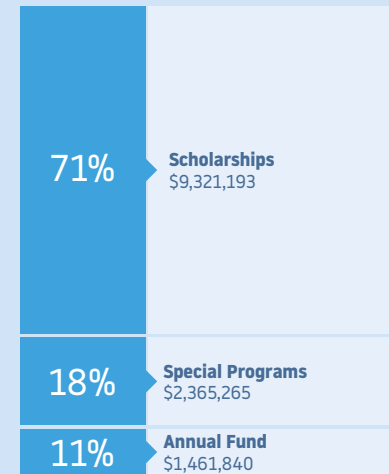

ANNUAL FUNDRAISING BY PROGRAM

The majority of CJA's annual fundraising is in support of student scholarships. Scholarship fundraising is essential to CJA's continued growth. By raising students' scholarships in four-year pledges, we are able to ensure we have the funds necessary to serve each student through their eighth-grade graduation. Over 85% of scholarship benefactors choose to renew their four-year commitment in support of our students. Some benefactors choose to support specific programs such as our Healthy Students Program, our College & Career Persistence Program, our High School Bridge Program or our Arts & Music Program. Others give to our General Operating Fund, which directs contributions to areas of the school that need it most.

Each year, we aim to raise more than our operating budget so we can continue to grow our enrollment responsibly while growing our reserves. With the completion of our campus expansion this past fall, we currently serve over 310 students and will grow to serve 426 students when we are at full capacity in 2027-28. Our goal is to secure a four-year scholarship for each student before they begin their fifth-grade year in June. Our third- and fourth-grade classes are funded separately by other generous donors.

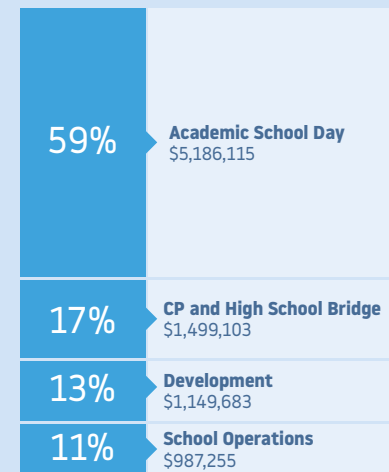
FUNDRAISING BY PROGRAM



SPENDING BY DEPARTMENT

The majority of spending at CJA during the 2023-24 school year directly supported the Academic School Day, ensuring a low student-to-teacher ratio and funding for three social workers, four learning interventionists and a full-time school nurse. This holistic approach addresses the needs of each student through the Jesuit tenet of *cura personalis*, care for the whole person. The Development Team accounted for 13% of our expenses and raised \$13.1 million including \$9.3 million in scholarship support for our students. The College & Career Persistence Team worked with our students and their families starting in sixth grade to help them prepare for the transition to high school as well as supporting our alumni in high school, post-secondary education and careers through the age of 25. The High School Bridge Team worked with our 10 partner schools serving 825 students in 7th-10th grade as they navigated their transitions to high school. The Operations Team managed technology, campus safety and the buildings and grounds for our students and alumni.
